

Title of the measure:	DK-32 Energy Labeling of Buildings

General description

The purpose of the labeling is to make the energy specifications of buildings visible for e.g. the owners, the buyers, and to deliver a plan showing the potential for reducing the energy of the house. The label, plan and documentation are composed by an Energy consultant and are paid by the seller/ the owner of the house.

The regulatory framework includes:

Act no. 636 of 19 June, 2012 on Energy Savings in Buildings

Regulation no. 673 of 25 June, 2012 on Energy Labeling of Buildings

EU Energy Performance of Buildings Directive (EPBD) 2010/31/EC

These measures were carried out mainly to fulfill the Kyoto commitments, in order to abate the emissions of carbon dioxide, CO₂ and reduce overall energy consumption in the household and tertiary sectors (Public service).

Tools developing the measures are mainly carried out by labeling activities and information/awareness, since target audience is private households and consumers.

The Danish Ministry of Climate, Energy and Building together with The Danish Energy Agency are charged with tasks of implementing the measures.
