

<b>Title of the measure:</b>	<b><i>LT22 – List of public procurements for which energy efficiency requirements are applied</i></b>

**General description**

When conducting public procurement of the goods specified in the approved list, the Governmental bodies, other authorities and bodies accountable to the Government of the Republic of Lithuania, the Office of the Prime Minister of the Republic of Lithuania, ministries, bodies under ministries, and other State authorities and bodies subordinate to ministries must specify the energy efficiency requirements in the technical specifications of the goods, except in the cases where there are no goods on the market that would meet the energy requirements in accordance with the approved list.

From 2008 till 2015 energy efficiency criteria were applied for the following (No 1023, 2008): circulation pumps; lightening lamps; computers, monitors, printers, copy machines; air conditioner; ovens; dish washers; washing machines; other.

From 1 July 2015, the list of public procurements for which energy efficiency requirements are applied consists of 27 goods, including washing machines, dryers, domestic refrigerating appliances, dish washers, electric and gas ovens, hobs and range hoods, TV sets, vacuum cleaners, lightening lamps, air conditioner of <=12 kW, cooling appliances, room heaters, office equipment, computers, transformers, pure water pumps, domestic and industrial fans, residential and non-residential ventilation units, electric motors, external power supplies, simple set-top boxes, tires.

**Historical data**

In 2013, value of purchased goods (except low value purchase), for which energy efficiency requirements were applied and which were acquired applying the public procurement procedures, was 61.34 million EUR and this made 1.6% from total value of goods which were acquired applying the public procurement procedures. In 2013, total value of low value purchases, for which energy efficiency requirements were applied, was 2.43 million EUR (Lithuanian Energy Agency, 2015).
